SOUTHERN ADIRONDACK LIBRARY SYSTEM JOINS ZEPHEIRA EXPERIMENTER PROGRAM

Saratoga Springs, NY, October 13, 2015 - The Southern Adirondack Library System (SALS) is excited to announce it will participate in an Experimenter Program with Zepheira, a provider of software and services that help make information more easily accessible on the Web. After an assessment of existing catalog records, Zepheira will design an approach to publish those records directly to the web using the power of Linked Data.

Also participating in the Experimenter Program is the Mohawk Valley Library System (MVLS). The endeavor is supported by funds allocated by Senator Farley to both library systems. SALS and MVLS receive technical support from the Joint Automation Project team, who will play a crucial role in this innovative restructuring of the consortium's catalog records.

The other two participants include the Westchester Library System, located in Tarrytown, NY, and Cedar Rapids Public Library in Iowa. The program will run through June 30, 2016.
