After completing her Bachelor's degree in Community Health – Clinical Science, at George Mason University, she moved back to New York to be closer to family. Here, she found her love for Harm Reduction and working with people who use drugs to meet them where they are at to provide the services they need to succeed. Sabrina comes with an extensive background in harm reduction, working to establish a syringe exchange program and Narcan program in the Adirondack North Country. From there, she landed at Adirondack Health Institute, implementing new and innovative ways to combat the opioid crisis in a seven county region across Northeastern New York focusing on prevention, treatment, and recovery. She has been working since October 2021 to create and develop relationships between substance use agencies and community agencies to increase awareness of opioid use disorder, discuss stigma, and find news ways to increase access to Narcan within the communities she services.
