What are the goals and objectives of your project?

The objective of this project to to analyze existing conditions of our Glen Street entry in order to determine remediation plans and costs to modify, repair and realign the existing entrance canopy, door threshold, and vestibule. Assistance with the DLD Construction Grant Application is included in the grant.

How will this project change the library building?

For at least four years architects, glass door installers, and facility staff have noticed sagging in the metal framework and increased problems with opening and locking the heavy doors. There are three doors but usually at least one is out of order. Safe egress does exist but we can make it better with a sturdier Glen Street entrance.

How will this project benefit your patrons?

Repair will allow easier access for patrons and ease of mind for staff who secure the building for closure.

The project will commence as soon as we are informed of the results of the application, spring 2025. Completion of this portion will be when the NYS Construction Grant Application is filed in late summer or early fall 2025.



In lieu of a traditional walk through of the facility with a willing volunteer, I am turning to a professionally written Building Conditions Assessment from Colliers Engineering & Design out of Rochester, NY. The firm was tasked to do a comprehensive building condition assessment of the existing Crandall Public Library. The objective of the project was to review and assess the existing physical building conditions, space types, and building systems (HVAC, electrical, data, piping, etc.) in order to develop a 5-year forward facing plan. The evaluation was deep and comprehensive. The final 88+-page document is attached to this application. The final report summarized all findings and recommendations. Rising to the top, as we suspected going in, is the Glen Street Entry Door and Canopy whose modification, repairs, and realignment are considered urgent. As Colliers is the author of the study, we wanted to hire professional experts who can lend their own unique evaluation to the pending project. We have asked Butler Rowland Mays Architects LLP to work with us on this stage of task development.

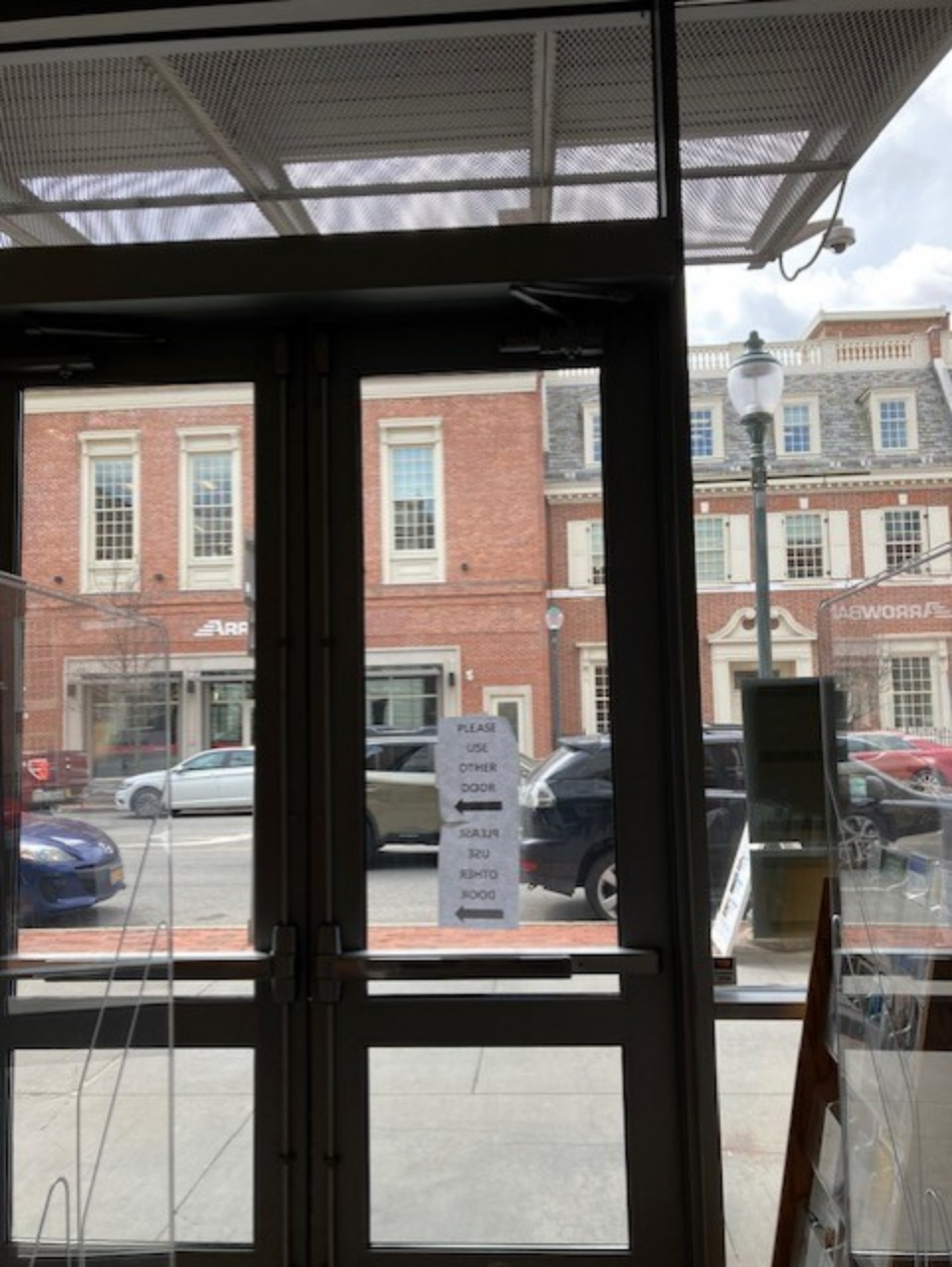

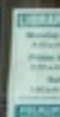
